



Wedding Time Planner

The primary consideration in selecting a collection that fits your wedding is the amount of coverage you need. Here are some guidelines to help you calculate an appropriate amount of time based on what you have planned for the day.

Pre-Ceremony: Dressing Room Candids, guests arriving, details of the site and decorations, and candid photos of events happening before the ceremony. <i>This time allows for the ushers to be available to seat guests 30 minutes prior to the ceremony. If seating will begin earlier, please allow additional time.</i>	1 hour
Posed photos with family/attendants*	½ to 1 hour
Processional-Ceremony-Recessional	½ hour (may vary)
Receiving Line**	20 to 30 minutes
Family & Attendants Formal Portraits*	20 to 35 minutes
Posed portraits of Bride & Groom alone (Plus any travel time)	15 to 20 minutes
Reception including:	2 to 5 hours
